(学術論文)  1 1 Japan' s Development Assistance to Kenya: An Analysis of Aid Policy Making (M.A. thesis)	author	2012年8月	筑波大学 人文社会科学 研究科 国際地域研究 専攻	In 1961 Japan became member of the Development Assistance Committee (DAC) of the Organization of Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) and during the last decades Japan has become one of the world' s main ODA providers, together with countries such as the United States, the United Kingdom or Germany. In its Official Development Assistance White Papers, the Japanese Government has always claimed its support in helping developing countries achieving economic and social progress, which is considered important not only for those countries themselves, but also for the well-being of Japan and of the international community. According to the principles of its ODA Charter, Japan will use its development assistance in dealing with global issues such as "poverty reduction", "sustainable growth", "environmental reconstruction" and "peace building". Although Japan has focused its ODA activity on Asian country for a long time, recently it has started to diversify the direction of its aid towards other developing countries of the world, including those in Africa. In 1993 Japan took an important step in this sense, holding the first Tokyo International Conference on African Development (TICAD I) where it expressed its support for the development of the African countries. Among the African countries, Kenya has received an important part of the Japanese development assistance, becoming one of the main recipients of the

This thesis focuses on analyzing Japan's foreign aid activity towards Kenya or, more specifically the position the Japan has adopted with regard to its OECD-DAC membership and Kenya's development plans.</p> <p>Historically, approximately 70% of world conflicts have been caused by territorial disputes. This is the case of the conflicts in Kashmir, Palestine or Crimea. In an age characterized by globalization, climate change and terrorism, an efficient administration of the state borders has become a crucial international issue. All modern countries are faced with the challenge of facilitating international trade and the free flow of labor, which are necessary for economic development, while at the same time defending their territories and citizens from international threats, such as terrorism. This paper analyzes the legal regime of borders in international law, focusing on the legal regime of the state border of Romania as a member of European Union.</p>
